## PARENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, RELEASE AND AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY

I/We, the aforementioned parents being the parents of the aforementioned player (herein called "my child"), for good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, do hereby agree and acknowledge:

1. That I/We have read and understood fully the attached RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement;
2. That I/We have explained to my/our child consequences of signing the said RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement;
3. That the said RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement is on the whole beneficial to my/our child;
4. That I/We do hereby release the Airdrie Little League Baseball Association, its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents from all liability, and do hereby waive as against the Association, its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents all recourse, claims, causes of actions of any kind whatsoever, in respect of damages I/We might suffer as a consequence of my/our child sustaining personal injury, death or property loss while participating in the Airdrie Little League Baseball programs and activities referred to in the above RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement, notwithstanding that such injury, death or loss may have been caused solely or partly by the negligence of the said Association, or any of its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors or agents.

That I/We do hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Airdrie Little League Baseball Association, its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents from any and all claims, demands, causes of actions of any kind whatsoever including those involving negligence on the part of the said Association or any of its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents, that may be made or initiated by, or on behalf of my child, arising out of or connected with my said child's preparation for or participation in any of the Airdrie Little League Baseball programs or activities referred to in the above RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement.

That I/We understand clearly that the Association is and shall be deemed to be acting for itself and as agent on behalf of and for the benefit of the members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents of the Association for the purposes set out in the above-stated clauses of this agreement.

## A FEW POINTS FROM AIRDRIE LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL

1. Registrations can be dropped off in person at various venues in Airdrie during the month of February 2007. Watch the Airdrie City View, Airdrie Echo and boulevard signs for exact dates and times. Registrations may be made anytime online at <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> or by mail, but must be received before April 1st. Failure to do so will result in a \$50 late fee. 2. The assessments and practices for all players will take place during the month of March 2007. Check <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> regularly for the locations and times for your player's assessment.
3. Coach's Clinics will be made available for all interested A.L.L. Coaches in late March 2007. Check <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> regularly for information.
4. Umpire Clinics for interested Umpires will also be made available. If interested in attending, check <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> regularly for information. Availability may be limited so be sure to check early and often.
5. Refunds of fees will only be granted prior to April 15<sup>th</sup>, upon receipt by the league player agent of written notice of the intention to withdraw a registered player from the league. Written notice must contain – First and Last Name and Division of League the player is being withdrawn from. Refunds **will not be** given once league play starts regardless if the player plays or not. The league executive have sole discretion on granting any refunds prior to and after play starts.

### \*Some quick notes:

- **Airdrie Little League web-site is <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com>. You will not receive any phone calls about practices or games or assessments, and the like. It is the parent's responsibility to check <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> for times and locations.**
- Airdrie Little League Baseball is run on a volunteer basis. Our success relies on your participation, assistance and support. As such we ask that everyone recognize the volunteer efforts and that the players are children. We ask that patience and consideration be given to our coaches, umpires, executive, baseball players, or anyone else involved, in cases of misunderstanding or dispute.
- We cannot advise in advance as to which schools are available for practices and assessments if forced to conduct these indoors. We will have access to some schools gymnasiums in March 2007. Once we know dates and times, <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> will be updated.
- No "street" shoes are allowed in the gymnasiums, even if you just put them on at your vehicle. The School Policy states that there is a 2 pair rule at all schools. You and your children must either bring an "indoor" and clean pair of athletic shoes (no spikes), no exceptions. Please adhere to all the School's regulations as this is a courtesy that they are extending to us and they may revoke the use if we give **any problems**.
- A "personal guard" or "can" is a Little League Regulation and we insist that all players wear the device at all practices and games.
