

END OF SEASON TOURNAMENT RULES

- Each game will start at its scheduled time. Games are limited to 90 minutes with no new inning starting after the 90 minutes point.
- Second team listed is home team. For example, Minors 1 vs. 2, team #2 would be home team.
- Winning team is required to report the final score and pitching rosters for both teams to the Tournament Director, located at the concession stand.
- PITCH COUNTS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Any violations may be subject to punishment.
- Each home team on diamond #2 will be required to provide **TWO** volunteers for the concession stand for the full two hour time period. Failure to do so may result in team penalties for the remainder of the tournament.
- If a team chooses to protest any game for whatever reason, it must be done so immediately after the game is completed. Inform the home plate umpire of your intentions and report to the Tournament Director immediately at the conclusion of the game.
- All players must play at least three (3) consecutive defensive outs and have one (1) at bat during each game.
- Rulings made by the Tournament Director are final and may not be further challenged or discussed once a decision has been rendered.

PITCHING

1. Any player on a regular season team may pitch. There is no limit to the number of pitchers a team may use in one game.
2. Players once removed from the mound may not return as a pitcher in the same game.
3. The coach must remove the pitcher when said pitcher reaches the limit for his/her age group as indicated below. The pitcher may remain in the game at another position.

League Age	7-8	50 pitches per day
	9-10	75 pitches per day
	11-12	85 pitches per day

*Exception: If a pitcher reaches the limit imposed they may continue to complete the series with the current batter that the limit was reached.

4. A pitcher who delivers one or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that game.
5. Pitchers must adhere to the following rest requirements.

41 or more pitches 2 complete days and one complete game.

21-45 1 complete day and one complete game.

1-20 no rest required.

6. 12 YEAR OLDS ARE PERMITTED TO PITCH ONE INNING FOR THE MINORS!
