

**A FEW POINTS FROM AIRDRIE LITTLE LEAGUE**  
**READ ALL OF THIS BEFORE REGISTERING YOUR CHILD**

1. Registrations can be dropped off in person at various venues in Airdrie during the month of March 2010. Watch the Airdrie City View, Airdrie Echo and Here's the Scoop for exact dates and times. Registrations may be made anytime online at <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> or by mail. If registering online and paying by cheque, payment must be received within 14 days of registration date or registration will be cancelled. All registrations must be received before March 31<sup>st</sup>. Registrations received after this date will be accepted at the discretion of the player agent. Registrations not received by Airdrie Little League prior to March 31<sup>st</sup> will be subject to a \$100.00 late fee.

3. The assessments and practices for all players will take place during the month of April 2010. Check <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> regularly for the locations and times for your child's assessment times.
4. Coach's Clinics will be made available for all interested ALLB. Coaches in April 2010. Check <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> regularly for information.
5. Umpire Clinics for interested Umpires will also be made available. If interested in attending, check <http://www.airdrielittleleague.com> regularly for information. Availability may be limited so be sure to check early and often.
6. Refunds of fees will only be granted if notice to withdraw from league and request for refund of fees in made prior to April 15/09 to Airdrie Little League President in writing of the intention to withdraw a registered player from the league. Written notice must contain – First and Last Name and League Division player is being withdrawn from. Refunds **will not be** granted after scheduled league play starts (May 3<sup>rd</sup>) regardless if the player plays or not, or the reason for withdrawing a player from the league. The league executive has sole discretion on granting any refunds prior to and after play starts.

## PARENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, RELEASE AND AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY

I/We, the aforementioned parents being the parents of the aforementioned player (herein called "my child"), for good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, do hereby agree and acknowledge:

1. That I/We have read and understood fully the attached RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement;
2. That I/We have explained to my/our child consequences of signing the said RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement;
3. That the said RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement is on the whole beneficial to my/our child;
4. That I/We do hereby release the Airdrie Little League Baseball Association, its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents from all liability, and do hereby waive as against the Association, its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents all recourse, claims, causes of actions of any kind whatsoever, in respect of damages I/We might suffer as a consequence of my/our child sustaining personal injury, death or property loss while participating in the Airdrie Little League Baseball programs and activities referred to in the above RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement, notwithstanding that such injury, death or loss may have been caused solely or partly by the negligence of the said Association, or any of its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors or agents.

That I/We do hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Airdrie Little League Baseball Association, its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents from any and all claims, demands, causes of actions of any kind whatsoever including those involving negligence on the part of the said Association or any of its members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents, that may be made or initiated by, or on behalf of my child, arising out of or connected with my said child's preparation for or participation in any of the Airdrie Little League Baseball programs or activities referred to in the above RELEASE, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK agreement.

That I/We understand clearly that the Association is and shall be deemed to be acting for itself and as agent on behalf of and for the benefit of the members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors and agents of the Association for the purposes set out in the above-stated clauses of this agreement.
